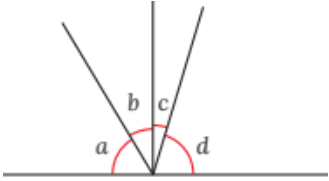

Maths: Write the angles in order of size from greatest to smallest.



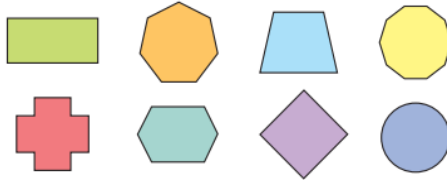
English: Write a short story about your favourite animal

English: Write your own biography.

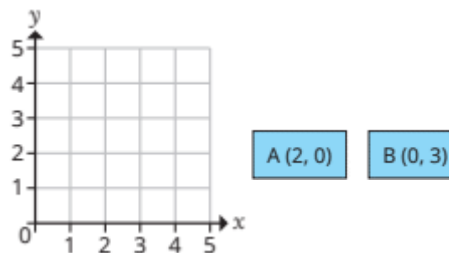
Spanish: Write a letter to Mrs Torna about the rooms you have in your house (in Spanish!)
