English: Write an example of a simple, compound and complex sentence.

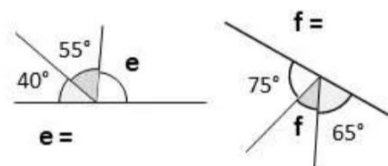
Science: Write a paragraph explaining how Newton discovered Gravity.

Maths: Calculate the missing angles.



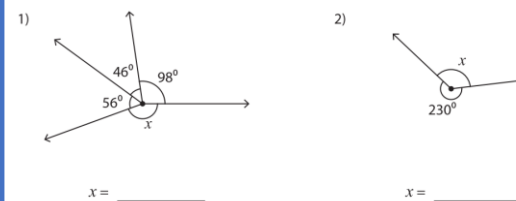
English: Write a conversation between two mysterious characters. How can you convey their personalities through dialogue?

Maths: Draw examples of regular and irregular polygons. Calculate the perimeter of your shapes.

English: Write five sentences which include information in parenthesis (brackets, commas or dashes).

PSHE: Design an informative poster about being a first aider, dealing with a medical emergency, calling an ambulance and administering first aid.

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Week 5 – 19th May

Maths: Mrs Romuzga draws a straight line on a coordinate grid. The straight line passes through points with the coordinates (1, 4) and (1, 8). Write the coordinates of three other points that the straight line passes through.

English: Read a newspaper article (there are many on the Newsround website!) and identify which statements are facts and which are opinions. Remember to ask an adult's permission if researching online.

Spanish: Make a list of 10 animals which live in England. Translate their names into Spanish.

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
