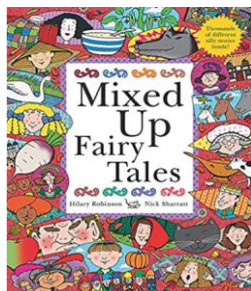




## Year 1 Homework – Spring 2

**Make sure you read every day.**



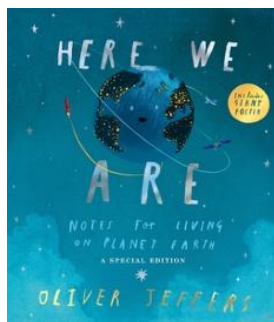
### Week 4- 17<sup>th</sup> March

### Week 2 – 3<sup>rd</sup> March

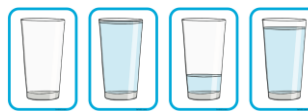
**Maths:** Make a list of 3 objects that are heavy and 3 that are light.
