

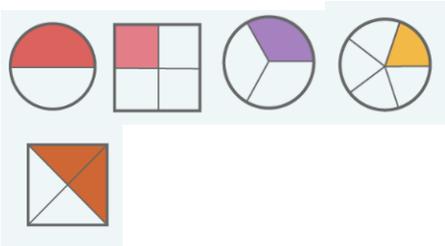
## Year 3 Homework – Spring 2

**Maths:** Are these fractions equivalent? Write **is** or **is not** to complete the sentences.

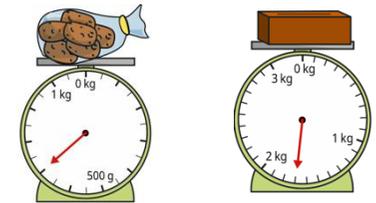
- a)  $\frac{1}{2}$  \_\_\_\_\_ equivalent to  $\frac{2}{4}$
