“My 3-digit number has 4 ones, the hundreds are double the ones and 2 tens”

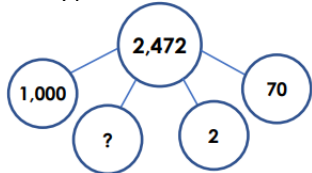
English: Write a poem using alliteration.
