Week 1 – 3<sup>rd</sup> November

**Maths:** Write your own word problems for area

**English:** Retell the story of St. George and the Dragon

**DT:** Write the recipe for your favourite soup.

Week 2 – 10<sup>th</sup> November

**Maths:** Write multiplication and division problems, focusing on your 3 and 6 times tables.

**English:** Write a newspaper report about a dragon attack at our school.

**RE:** Imagine you are donating something important to you. Write a letter to the person who may receive it, explaining why you are giving it away.

Week 3 – 17<sup>th</sup> November

**Maths:** Create your own equal groups of seven with objects around your house.

**English:** Write a non-chronological report about an animal of your choice.

**History:** Design your own Mayan god. Think about what they represent and why they would be worshipped.

Week 4 – 24<sup>th</sup> November

**Maths:** Work out how much it will cost to buy the ingredients for your favourite meal. You can check the prices online or go to your local supermarket!

**English:** Write a recipe for your favourite meal.

**History:** Write your teacher a secret message using the Mayan alphabet.

Week 5 – 1<sup>st</sup> December

**Maths:** Create addition and subtraction fact families for 4-digit numbers.

**English:** Write a character description about someone in your family.

**Science:** Draw and annotate a diagram of the digestive system.

Week 6 – 8<sup>th</sup> December

**Maths:** What is the number?

- The number has six digits.
- All the of the digits are odd.
- The thousands digit is bigger than 3 but less than 4.
- The tens digit represents the month of July.
- The hundreds digit is the same as  $270 \div 30$ .
- The ones digit is the number of angles in a triangle
- The hundred thousands digit is  $\frac{1}{10}$  of 30.
- The ten thousands digit is  $\frac{1}{3}$  of the hundreds digit

**English:** Write a setting description about our school.

**Spanish:** Write a letter to Miss Torna, telling her who your different family members are.

Week 7 – 15<sup>th</sup> December

**Maths:** We went sledding when it snowed last week. There were 14 kids in our group. 13 kids went down the hill 9 times. The final kid went down the hill 10 times. How many times did we go down the hill altogether?

**English:** Write an adventure story that takes place during winter. Remember to use vivid descriptions!

**DT/PSHE:** Design a balance meal for your teacher. Consider using a meal plate to help you and use pictures!
