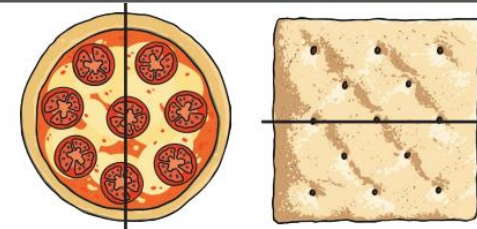

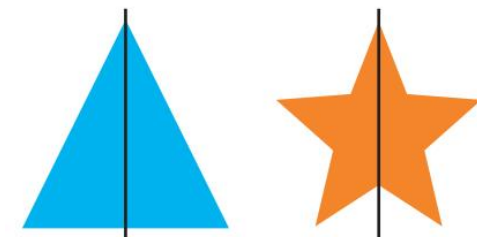

Features of Text Type: Picture Books

Illustrations tell the story in wordless picture books. It is essential that they are memorable and detailed, to encourage the reader to study them and 'find' the story.

Features of Text Type: Poetry

In poetry, end of line punctuation, such as a comma or a full stop, is used to support rhythm and performance.

Features of Text Type: Recounts

Recounts are written to **retell** a series of real or imaginary events.

Events are usually recounted in the **first person** using the **personal pronoun 'I'**.

Events are recounted in **chronological order** using '**sequencing language**' (such as *adverbs of time*) to guide the reader through the text.

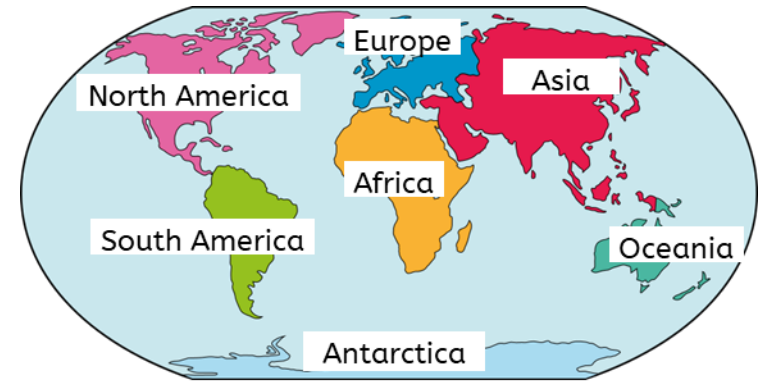

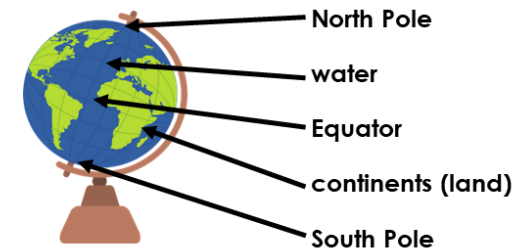
Our World

We live on the Earth. The Earth is at the global scale. The Earth's land is split into seven large areas of land that are called **continents**. There are seven continents in the world:

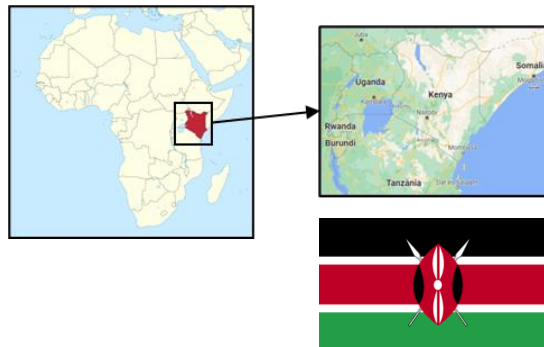


The Globe
